PRESS RELEASE

On 4-12-18, at approx. 10:20 p.m., a Crow Wing County deputy attempted to make a stop on a vehicle that was driving without headlights in the area of Laurel St. and S. 4th St. in Brainerd. When the deputy activated his red lights, the vehicle fled west bound on Laurel Street at very high speeds failing to stop at several stop signs.

As the deputy pursued the vehicle west bound on Laurel Street, the vehicle lost control on the 90 degree corner at Highland Scenic Drive. The vehicle left the roadway, hit a power pole and rolled several times before coming to rest in a wooded area. The driver, a juvenile female who had escaped from a treatment facility, was taken to Essentia E. R. for treatment of minor injuries and then taken into custody. The vehicle she was driving was also stolen from Litchfield, MN. The Juvenile female is being held on felony charges.

Other agencies involved were Brainerd Police Dept. and Baxter Police Dept., and North Ambulance.
