Crow Wing County Offices to Modify Service Delivery

Based on new guidance from the President about limiting unnecessary person-to-person contact, effective Tuesday, March 17, 2020, Crow Wing County will be modifying how it delivers services to the public and will not be allowing public entry to county buildings through at least March 31, 2020. Crow Wing County remains open to serving the public and will now do so through telephone, e-mail, and an array of on-line services available through our website: crowwing.us

According to Board Chair, Paul Koering, "These are unprecedented times and requires unprecedented measures. We are doing everything we can to still provide vital county services to those who need them while also trying to limit person-to-person contact. We are still open for business, just not in the traditional way and helping to limit the spread of the coronavirus is paramount in our thinking."
